Riverside County to share cost of Wildomar fire station

Riverside County supervisors unanimously endorsed a cost-sharing arrangement Tuesday that would allow a second fire station to be built in Wildomar on the east side of Interstate 15 if Wildomar decides to incorporate.

Fire Chief John Hawkins said a new fire station would help fill gaps in existing coverage areas.

Supervisor Bob Buster, who represents Wildomar, said it would be appropriate whether the community incorporates or not for the county to share in the cost of a new fire station there.

County staff will begin negotiating a cost-sharing agreement should Wildomar become a city. An incorporation vote could come as early as this fall.
